CLIMATE INACTION at the university of michigan

THE CURRENT REALITY AT U-M:

- 1. U-M's climate targets are at the **bottom** of Big 10 schools (OSU committed to carbon neutrality over 10 years ago).¹
- 2. We had a committee it failed. Committees are useless without accountability. U-M has largely ignored the recommendations of the 2015 President's Greenhouse Gas Reduction Committee.²
- 3. U-M's new Commission has a poison pill: putting a DTE rep on the commission is a direct conflict of interest for a rapid transition away from fossil fuels.³
- **4.** U-M is spending \$80 million to expand fossil fuel use at the Central Power Plant (CPP), with construction underway.^{4,5}
- **5.** U-M has \$900 million invested in "proven oil and natural gas reserves" and "companies that service the oil and gas industry," in addition to \$100 million invested in fossil fuel companies via public holdings.⁶
- 6. Fossil fuel investments are not slowing down: U-M added \$340 million to fossil fuel investments in 2017 alone.⁶
- 7. U-M chose to arrest 10 people after a 7.5 hour peaceful sit-in, rather than commit to a 1-hr public meeting on U-M climate policy. They're currently pressing charges. 9

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

TELL U-M TO STEP UP ON CLIMATE ACTION BY:

- 1. Committing to Carbon Neutrality by 2030
- 2. Removing DTE, a fossil fuel company with a track record of gross environmental justice offenses^{7,8} from the Commission on Carbon Neutrality to an advisory role
- 3. Halting the expansion of fossil fuel use at the Central Power Plant
- 4. Divesting from fossil fuel companies, who continue to hamstring climate action
